The South Hams Arts Forum (SHAF) and the Arts Trail are thriving! SHAF has currently in excess of 150 members and this year sees the largest number of participating artists for the Arts Trail ever! So, plenty to see and new venues to visit!

The Arts Trail is a well-established annual event that showcases an extensive range of work created by talented local artists. It gives visitors the rare opportunity to meet artists in a variety of venues across the South Hams. You'll be able to visit artists in their own homes and studios, as well as in galleries and interesting public venues, such as Kingsbridge Market Hall, Avon Mill Café at Loddiswell and Newton Ferrers Yacht Club.

With more participating artists this year, the venues are all fairly close to one another, so it'll be easy to follow the Yellow signs with black arrows all around the South Hams from Dartington and Totnes, over to Mount Batten and Plymstock, and down to Stokenham, Kingsbridge and Thurlestone.

Visitors will be able to spend time with artists, discussing their work, with the opportunity to purchase a unique piece of art. For the first time this year, there are workshops, run by exhibiting artists, that visitors will be able to book onto (see page 5). This will be an amazing opportunity to learn new skills and be creative, with the guidance of an experienced artist. Early booking is advised as these will be popular and spaces are limited.

The 2023 Arts Trail runs from October 14th to 29th. Please check the opening days and hours of individual venues as these do vary. Contact details for each venue and artist are available in the artist's profile in the brochure. You will find a helpful chart of opening times for your convenience in page 4, and an index of artists and a map of the region on pages 34-35 of the brochure.

We invite you to follow the Trail, visit as many venues as possible and discover the latest works of your favourite artists – as well as discovering some new ones! Have a wonderful time and don't forget to stop for a delicious lunch or cream tea at one of the cafes, hotels, pubs, and restaurants advertised in the brochure. Most important of all, have FUN on this year's Arts Trail!

Hannah Wisdom Textiles

Interview by Eleanor King

Hannah has found the perfect location for her textile art business in the creatively buzzing workshops adjoining a former seaplane hangar at what was RAF Mount Batten. Dating from 1917, these hangars represent an important survival of early defensive aviation structures in the Plymouth area. It seems very fitting that Hannah's art and collage craft is a sympathetic marriage of historic navigation charts and marine or coastal motifs made from recycled fabrics.

Hannah, did you have any formal art education after leaving school?

No, this has all come from a lifetime of sewing, dress-making, quilting and embroidery. I realised I can create my own designs, and my own interpretation of the wildlife typically found around the location of the chosen charts.


You've developed a very recognisable brand.

There's a continuity achieved using admiralty maritime charts as backgrounds across all the products. The fabric marine motifs appliqued over them are quite graphic, and contrast with the fine detail of the cartography. Only recently I recognised the commercial potential of the craft.

How long have you been selling this range of household products?

After doing free-motion embroidery with Jackie Gale (another SHAF member), I made a couple of embroidered pictures, the first was the Eddistone Lighthouse. I had been out in the boat with my husband, and as we bobbed around

the lighthouse watching the Cormorants on a stump, drying their wings, I thought about its history and the extraordinary achievement of building such a thing on



How easy is it to source the original charts?

Quite easy, the Marine Biological Association gave me a huge stack after clearing out their library, including a fascinating 1920's one of Antartica that records Scott's planned route. And then the various harbour authorities will donate old charts. I love that they are authentic, vintage, and whilst I can digitally edit out the worst of any wear and tear marks, the scanning process reproduces such an amazing quality you can hardly differentiate the prints from the originals. Over the course of building the business I've had to trial many different producers, suppliers and printers. I try to use Devon suppliers mostly, across the range of printed products, keeping the footprint to a minimum if I can.
